

## FILM RESOURCES: FIVE TYPES OF SHOTS USED IN FILM MAKING

### 1. **Establishing Shot**

The opening shot that shows you where the film is taking place. It establishes the story.



### 2. **Wide Shot**

A large field of vision in the shot. It shows the full subject.



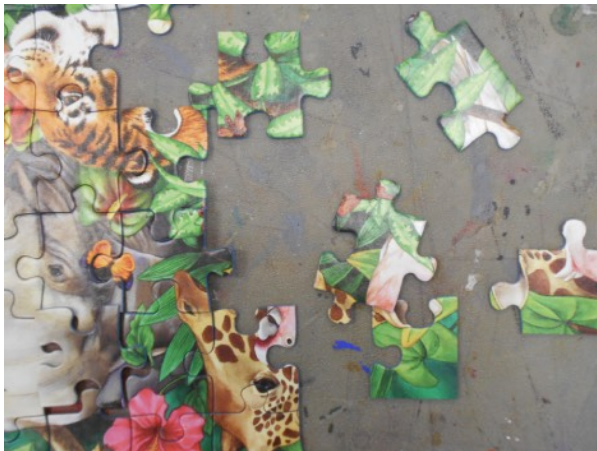
### 3. Two Shot

For use in big groups only - focuses in on two people in the crowd.



### 4. Close up

Close up shot of one thing - a person, a place or a thing.



## 5. **Over the shoulder**

Close up view of the main person's activity or focus, filmed from his/her perspective.
