

Community Art: Share your joys

Materials:

Crayons and Watercolors, watercolor paper

Objective: During this time of Shelter in Place, we need more than ever to be able to make connections. Public art and window art are ways that people stay connected. Students will complete an activity with words, and an image along the theme of connection, support and solidarity.

Activity:

1) Draw a picture of something that brings you joy

- A rainbow
- A pet, or an animal
- Your family
- A book
- An activity you love (reading, riding your bike, playing basketball, riding a horse)
- Anything else!

2) Color with crayons

3) Write a sentence, with bright colors, that expresses joy or support

- Stay Healthy
- We're all in this together
- Hang in there
- Wash your hands
- Be safe

4) Optional: Use your water colors to do a wax resist. To do this, take a light color paint and paint over your picture. The crayon should pop out!

5) When your picture is done (and dry) put it in your window!
